You MUST be registered and have PAID BOTH the conference registration and contest entry fee no later than 11:59p.m.CST September 15, 2022. NO LATE contest entries accepted.

- Submit your personal essay or reported narrative submission AND this completed form to mayborncontest@unt.edu no later than **11:59 p.m.CST September 15 2022**
- In the email subject line, state your last name–contest type–title. Example: Smith–personal essay–The Long Road.
- In the body of the email include your full name and contact information.
- MULTIPLE ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED VIA SEPARATE EMAILS.
- Late entries are NOT eligible for prize money but may be considered for workshops.
